Field of the Invention This invention relates to the treatment of gingivitis and other inflammatory conditions in human or animal oral tissues. 2. Description of Related Art Gingivitis is the inflammation of gingival tissue over the teeth, which results in excess accumulation of dental plaque. Because plaque serves as a site of bacterial proliferation, it is considered an important causative agent of gingivitis. Once the process of gingivitis is initiated, the consequences of the infection can become severe, if left untreated. Acute gingivitis can lead to periodontal disease, including gum recession, bleeding, and tooth loss. Chronic gingivitis may cause tooth decay, tooth sensitivity, and halitosis. Gum recession is the loss of gum tissue from the tooth root. Routinely, gum recession is due to disease, trauma or genetics. Tooth loss commonly results from gum recession and other root diseases. Tooth sensitivity is due to changes in the surface microstructure or to changes in the chemical composition of the tooth surface. Tooth sensitivity may be due to hypersensitivity of the tooth surface (also referred to as "intrinsic tooth sensitivity") or to irritation of the nerve ending in the tooth pulp (also known as "phantom tooth sensitivity"). Tooth sensitivity is perceived as a sharp, irritating and unpleasant sensation which occurs when temperatures rise in the tooth pulp, when the saliva or other fluids migrate along the root surface, or when foods or liquids come in contact with the tooth surface. Tooth sensitivity can also be due to the natural breakdown of enamel. Halitosis is the undesirable chemical or oral odour emanating from the mouth.
